*Amateurs are racers who did not finish in the top ten in the Dakar scratch within the past five years, and whose fame is not directly tied to an achievement in motor sports.

Note: Any failure to pay will automatically result in disqualification from the Dakar rally for the next five years.

THESE FEES INCLUDE

- **Return boat trip for vehicles from Europe to Buenos Aires and from Buenos Aires to Europe (the shipping and unloading port in Europe will be announced later)**
- Sporting charges
- Medical assistance
- Food and beverages at the bivouacs
- Insurance, which includes civil liability motor insurance valid along the entire route as well as medical repatriation insurance
- **GPS and distress beacon rental**
- **IriTrack satellite tracking system rental**
- **Sentinel system rental**
- **Refuelling during specials (but not during road sections and at the bivouac)**
- **Eco-contribution**

THESE FEES DO NOT INCLUDE

- **Transport of one trunk and two trunks. A.S.O. can provide the competitors with a transport service : two wheels and four wheels (only 1 trunk and two wheels accessible per day). This additional service, optional and individual, will be invoiced at the price of 500 €.**
- Visa charges (mandatory)
- **Satellite telephones (this is not mandatory)**
- Fuel during the road sections and at the bivouac
- Travel costs
